PDF Converter – PDF to Word & Image

Summary

PDF Converter – PDF to Word & Image performs every conversion, compression and resize operation **entirely on your device**. Your files are never uploaded, never transmitted, and never seen by us or by anyone else.

We do not collect personal data. We do not use analytics, advertising, crash-reporting or tracking services. There are no user accounts. The app works with the device offline — in airplane mode — because nothing it does requires a network connection.

2. Information We Do Not Collect

We do **not** collect, receive, store or process any of the following:

- Your name, email address, phone number or postal address
- Account credentials — the app has no sign-in and no user accounts
- Device identifiers, advertising IDs or IP addresses
- Location data
- Usage analytics, event tracking, session recordings or heatmaps
- Crash reports or diagnostic telemetry
- Contacts, calendar, microphone or health data
- Any content, name, path or metadata belonging to a file you open in the app

We operate no servers, no database and no backend of any kind for this application. There is no mechanism in the app by which your data could reach us.

3. Information We Collect

None.

The app stores a small number of your own settings on your device only (see section 6). These never leave the device and are not transmitted to us or to any third party.

4. File Processing

The app provides twelve tools that convert, compress or resize files:

Category	Tools
PDF	PDF to Word, PDF to Image, Compress PDF
Word	Word to PDF, Compress Word
Images	Image to PDF, JPG to PDF, PNG to PDF, Compress Image, Compress JPG, Compress PNG, Resize Image

4.1 All processing is local

Every one of these tools runs **on your device**, using processing code that ships inside the application. Specifically:

- **PDF files** are parsed, rendered and rebuilt on your device.
- **Word (.docx) files** are unpacked, read and rewritten on your device.
- **Images** are decoded, re-encoded and resized on your device.

There is no cloud conversion service, no conversion API, no proxy server and no upload path anywhere in the application.

4.2 How a file moves through the app

1. You choose a file using your device's own file picker, photo picker or camera. 2. The app reads that file into memory. 3. The conversion runs on your device's processor. 4. The result is written to the app's private temporary folder on your device. 5. You choose what happens next — save it, share it, open it, or discard it.

At no point in this sequence does the file, or any information derived from it, leave your device.

5. Network Activity

The application makes no network requests.

We have verified this against the source code: the app contains no HTTP client, no socket code, no cloud SDK and no remote URL of any kind. Fonts and animations are bundled inside the application package rather than downloaded.

5.1 About the Android INTERNET permission

The Android manifest declares the `INTERNET` permission. As of version 1.0.0 the application does not use it: the typeface it once allowed to be downloaded is now shipped inside the app. The permission is therefore declared but unused, and no data is sent through it. We disclose this rather than omit it, because a declared permission is visible to you on the store listing and you are entitled to know what it does — which here is nothing.

6. Storage and Retention

6.1 Converted files (temporary)

Results are written to the application's **private temporary directory**, which is sandboxed by the operating system and not readable by other apps.

- Temporary files are deleted automatically when they are more than **24 hours**

old, and this cleanup also runs each time the app starts.

- If you leave the result screen without saving, the temporary file is deleted immediately.

- Once you save or share a file, the copy you created belongs to you and is governed by your device and by whichever app you shared it with.

6.2 Settings

The app stores the following on your device using the platform's standard preference storage:

Stored value	Purpose
Interface language	Remembers the language you selected
Theme (light / dark / system)	Remembers your appearance choice
First-launch completed	Shows the introduction only once
Compression notice acknowledged	Remembers that you have seen the Compress PDF warning

That is the complete list. It contains no personal information and no file data.

6.3 Logs

The app writes diagnostic messages to the local device console only, and these are visible only while a developer has the device connected. Logs never leave the device, never contain file contents, and do not contain file names or paths in release builds. There is no remote logging service.

7. Third-Party Services

No third-party service receives any data from this application.

The app is built with open-source software libraries that run entirely on your device — for reading and writing PDF and Office file formats, encoding images, picking and sharing files, and storing your settings. These are code libraries compiled into the app, not services: none of them transmits anything to a third party in the way this app uses them.

The application contains:

- **No** analytics SDK
- **No** advertising SDK or ad network
- **No** crash-reporting service
- **No** authentication or identity provider
- **No** cloud storage or cloud processing service
- **No** payment or subscription provider

If you choose to **share** a converted file, your device's own share sheet hands that file to the app you select. What happens to it afterwards is governed by that app's privacy policy, not by ours.

8. Permissions

The app requests only the permissions its tools need, and only at the moment they are needed. You may decline any of them; the affected feature will simply be unavailable.

Permission	Why it is requested
READ_MEDIA_IMAGES	To let you choose photos to convert, compress or resize (Android 13 and later)
READ_EXTERNAL_STORAGE	The same, on Android 12 and earlier
WRITE_EXTERNAL_STORAGE	To save results to shared storage on Android 9 and earlier
CAMERA	Only if you choose to capture a photo instead of picking one. The camera is declared as optional hardware, so the app installs on devices without one
INTERNET	Declared but unused — see section 5.1

iOS

Permission	Why it is requested
Photo Library	To let you choose photos to convert, compress or resize

Permission	Why it is requested
Photo Library (add)	To save a converted image back to your library, if you ask for that
Camera	Only if you choose to capture a photo instead of picking one
Files / Documents	To let you choose a document to convert

The app does not request location, contacts, microphone, calendar, Bluetooth, tracking or notification permissions.

9. Security

- Files are processed on your device; there is no transmission to secure, and no server that could be breached.
- Temporary files live in the app's private sandbox directory, which the operating system protects from other applications.
- Temporary files are removed automatically as described in section 6.1.
- The app holds no credentials, tokens or keys, because it connects to nothing.

No method of electronic storage is completely secure. However, because your files never leave your device, the security of your data depends on the security of your own device rather than on ours.

10. Your Rights

Data-protection laws including the EU/UK General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA) give you rights to access, correct, delete, export and restrict the processing of your personal data, and to object to it.

We hold no personal data about you. There is nothing for us to disclose, correct, export or erase, and nothing to sell — we do not sell or share personal information under any definition, because we do not have any. This is a property of how the app is built, not a policy choice we could quietly reverse.

11. Data Deletion

Because we store nothing, there is no account to close and no deletion request to submit.

To remove everything the app has placed on your device:

- Clear cache** — Settings → Clear cache, inside the app, removes temporary

files immediately.

- **Uninstall the app** — this removes the app's temporary files and your stored settings completely.

Files you deliberately saved or shared are yours; they remain where you put them until you delete them.

12. Children's Privacy

The app is not directed at children and does not knowingly collect personal information from anyone, including children under 13 (or the equivalent minimum age in your jurisdiction). Since no personal data is collected from any user, no personal data is collected from children either. There is no advertising, no tracking and no social feature in the app.

13. International Data Transfers

No data is transferred anywhere. Because the app sends no information off your device, there is no cross-border transfer of personal data, and no transfer mechanism such as Standard Contractual Clauses is required.

14. Changes to This Policy

If this policy changes, we will update the "Last updated" date above and publish the revised policy at the address linked from the app. Material changes — in particular any change to the local-only processing described in section 4 — will be highlighted clearly, and the app's store listing will be updated to match.

We will never change the app to transmit your files without saying so plainly in this policy first.
